To fish the waters you can belong to one of the established angling clubs clubs. Listed on the Face book .

Another way is to join the T.A.A. on a yearly ticket £20. or on a day ticket £5. with concessions. Please ask when going to purchase either.

These can be obtained by visiting the reception area at the Local Lakeside Centre. (swimming Pool) The year ticket allows you only to fish T.A.A. waters.

Not other angling clubs waters. The day ticket is only for either lake at Killingworth Dawn till Dusk. We have to adhere to the rules for all venues. Please take your litter or any fishing tackle away with you , its one that gets angling a bad name. There are quite a lot of species . Roach. Bream. Carp. Perch. Rudd. Pike. crucians, all of various sizes. So tight lines.
