

The Reigh, Throckley, Newburn

The Reigh is part of the Tyne Riverside Country Park.

The Reigh has been with the T.A.A. since the 70s.

There is no Day tickets for this water. T.A.A. Members Only or yearly membership holders.

To get to the Pond best to park up on Blayney Row , so head for the Newburn Leisure Centre. Blayney Row is signed posted before the Big Lamp Pub. Travel all the way up parking is allowed on the right hand side. I travel light. Rods, landing net handle, landing net, keep net and small box or seat. You then walk to the top turn right this brings you behind the Terraced houses, where on the left you will see a bridle gate, i use a small fishing trolley it just gets you through the gate . then keep to the right on the bridle path in the farmers field . carry on to the end follow the pathway to bring you to the bottom of the pond in front of the notice board I am 73. and it takes me from my car 12 to 15 mins lovely walk.

From the notice board follow the path up to the pond on your left. There are 8 pegs to fish from , these were built in 2015 and are still solid to fish from . There has been a work party lately to strim the vegetation and carefully trim back hanging branches.

Take time to look at the pegs and a walk to the end of the pond this brings you to what was known as the Perch pool. Another work Party will be coming soon to get the weed from the top of the water broken off during the winter . So do come when asked. Thanks. People say divnt fish there, there nee fish in there. WELL. SEE MY PICS FROM MY LATEST VISITS over the last few weeks. Again Please take your Litter and take 5 mins, to check no tackle items are left, home with you, there being no bins.

Always on T.A.A. venues you must have club card or yearly ticket with you ,and of course E/A Licence. There have been 2 fish stockings, Latest 2nd Feb 24. Roach 500. Bream 100. Tench 50. Rudd 500.
